Recital Performance Fees

- <u>Recital Participation Fee</u> \$100 per dancer and \$40 per additional dancer in the same family. This includes 2 tickets to one of the two shows. **If a family has multiple dancers, this still only includes 2 tickets. More can be purchased when tickets go on sale in March.**
- <u>Costume Fee</u> \$90 per costume per class. This will include a garment bag and tights if needed.
 - If a dancer signs up for the recital after January 15th, the costume fee is \$120 for rush delivery. This will also include a garment bag and tights if needed.

**Dance Shoes NOT Included with Costumes **

The Recital Participation Fee and Costume Fee is due at the time of registration so that we can begin ordering costumes ASAP.
